NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough of Sharon Hill Council, Delaware County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, will consider the adoption of the an Ordinance on Thursday, August 9, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the Sharon Hill Borough Hall, 250 Sharon Avenue, Sharon Hill, Pennsylvania:

The proposed Ordinance requires compliance with standards that are stricter than the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code in the following ways:

1. Alterations, Renovations & Repairs — The Proposed Ordinance will require permits for renovations/repairs consistent with the 2015 International Residential Code.
2. Adoption of a Definition of “Ordinary Repairs” in excess of the minimum standards of the Uniform Construction Code for use in interpretation and enforcement of the UCC and the 2015 International Residential Code.

At the conclusion of the Public Hearing, during the regular Borough Council Meeting, the Borough Council may consider the adoption of the Ordinance.
