Call to Order 7:11 PM The Honorable Hykeem Green, Mayor

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call: William Felder (**WF**), Tanya Cavalieri (**TC**), Sharon Booker (**SB**), Hykeem Green (**HG**), Keith Martinez (**KM**), Sandra Holcombe (**SH**), Solicitor Sean Kilkenny, Rodney Hill (**RH**) (excused)

Acceptance of Councilman Hykeem Green's Letter of Resignation – Borough Administrator, Nafis Nichols advised that the resignation was received prior to the reorganization meeting by the acting Borough Manager, Barbarann Keffer.

William Morgan (acting as Meeting secretary), calls for Nomination and Election of President:

WF nominated SB; KM and SH nominated TC

Mayor conducts roll call for voting

WF nominated SB, SB receives 2 Yes, 3 No

SH moves to nominate TC and KM seconds the nomination

Roll call to vote: TC receives 3 Yes / 2 No

Nomination and Election of Vice President

SH nominates KM

SB nominates WM

Roll call: KM receives 3 Yes, 2 No

Mayor Green calls for nomination of Pro Tempore Appointment of Vacancy Board Chair: President TC nominates Carolyn Garrett; no other nominations presented.

Mayor Green calls for the Public Hearing for the 2022 CDBG application and turns meeting over to newly appointed Council President, President TC

TC thanks council and acknowledges community presence at meeting and strives to do her best.

CDBG presentation given by Treasurer, William Morgan Community Development Block Grants, States it was advertised in media. Provided documents and report from engineer. Advised deadline approaching.

1. Rehabilitation of Sewer lines and small sewer draining facilities
2. Traffic calming / streetscape improvements
3. Weiderwax Park / Memorial Park improvement
4. Sidewalk replacement
5. Realigning of sewer lines

Public Comments – No public comments

Council Comments – WF inquired if the repairs for the unit block of High St are underway; also inquired about the type of improvements to be made at Weiderwax Park.

WM emphasized the importance of voting on CDBG by January 7, 2022

President TC inquired if certain projects are prioritized over others. WM advised prioritization of sewer work.

President TC calls for motion on two projects for grants: Memorial Park and rehabilitation of sewer lines

WF had inquiries about the prioritization of sewer line repairs. SB inquired if the sewer line work is a continuation of a previous project. Borough Administrator, Nafis Nichols advised councilors to review engineers report. Solicitor Kilkenny interjected and stressed the importance of the voting deadline.

President TC called for vote. WF moved, SB seconded

Agreed to move forward with rehabilitation of sewer lines and Memorial Park improvement.
