### **MAYORAL PROCLAMATION**

#### **HEAT ADVISORY AWARENESS AND SAFETY PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, extreme heat events create significant risks to the health and safety of residents, especially older adults, young children, individuals with medical conditions, outdoor workers, and other vulnerable members of the community; and

WHEREAS, excessive heat can result in serious heat-related illnesses, including heat exhaustion and heat stroke, which may become life-threatening without proper precautions, awareness, and timely assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sharon Hill recognizes the importance of preparing residents for periods of extreme heat by promoting safety awareness, hydration, access to cooling resources, and community support; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sharon Hill recognizes that extreme heat also creates risks for household pets and animals, who may experience heat-related distress, dehydration, and serious health complications when exposed to excessive temperatures; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sharon Hill recognizes the period from July 1, 2026, through July 7, 2026, as a period of heightened heat awareness due to forecasted excessive temperatures and the potential risks associated with extreme heat conditions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ED BOOKER, Mayor of the Borough of Sharon Hill, Pennsylvania, do hereby issue this Heat Advisory Proclamation and encourage all residents to take the following safety precautions:

- Drink plenty of water and stay hydrated;
- Avoid strenuous outdoor activities during the hottest parts of the day;
- Seek air-conditioned or shaded areas when necessary;
- Never leave children, pets, or vulnerable individuals unattended in vehicles;
- Provide pets with fresh water, shade, and protection from extreme heat;
- Avoid walking pets on hot pavement or surfaces that may burn their paws;
- Check on neighbors, family members, and those who may need assistance.


